

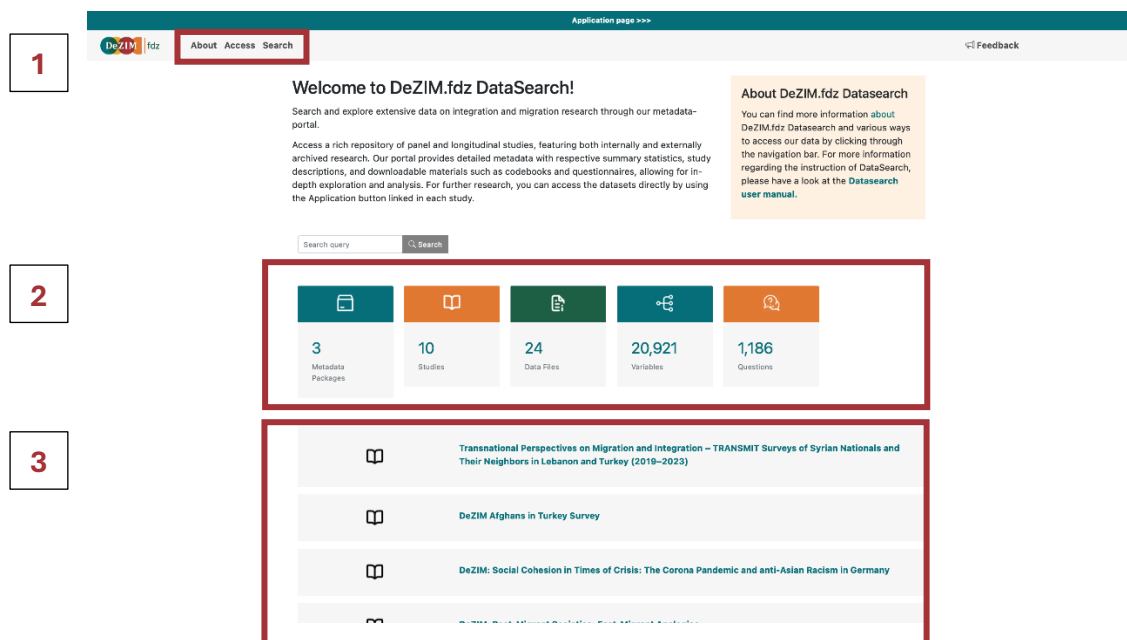
DataSearch User Manual

Instructions

DeZIM.fdz [DataSearch](#) is a metadata portal designed for research on integration and migration. The platform provides access to an extensive repository of metadata, including descriptions of studies, data files, variables, and questions, as well as associated downloadable materials (e.g., codebooks, questionnaires). In addition, it offers the opportunity to apply for access to full datasets.

Welcome Page

When you open DeZIM.fdz DataSearch, you will see the top navigation bar, the main search boxes and a list of available studies. This handbook provides a detailed overview of these elements and explains how to use each section efficiently.



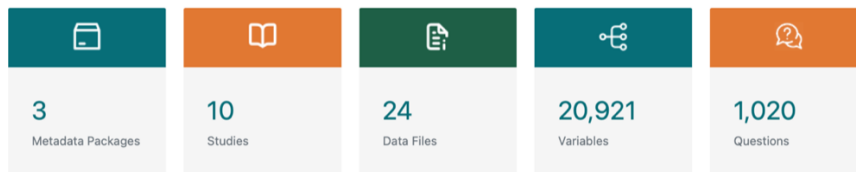
1. Top Navigation Bar

The navigation bar is depicted at the top:

About Access Search

- **About:** Provides an overview of DeZIM.fdz DataSearch, including its purpose.
- **Access:** Outlines the available data access paths and explains the different levels of data anonymization (i.e., download, remote access, and onsite access).
- **Search:** Serves as the central search interface for exploring studies, variables, data files, survey questions, and related metadata.




2. Main Search Boxes



- **Metadata Packages:** Contains three metadata packages based on controlled vocabularies. These provide standardized keywords (concepts), subject classifications (diversification criteria), and information on the form and type of data (data types).
- **Studies:** Lists all studies currently archived in DeZIM.fdz. At present (January 2026), the repository includes 10 studies archived at DeZIM.fdz, with additional studies to be added continuously. Each study record provides detailed information on research topics, subjects, citations, documentation, and access information.
- **Data Files:** Displays all available data files. Users can search for specific files and apply filters, including the option to view deprecated items.
- **Variables:** Provides detailed metadata on variables contained in datasets, including variable labels, response categories, associated questions, and summary statistics (available for the download-version).
- **Questions:** Includes survey or interview questions from the archived studies, presenting the full question wording, instructions, and links to the corresponding variables.

Title **DeZIM: Post-Migrant Societies: East-Migrant Analogies**

Abstract The research project "Post-Migrant Societies: East-Migrant Analogies" conducted by the German Center for Integration and Migration Research (DeZIM), explores parallels in the marginalization of disadvantaged groups in Germany. It involves a general population survey with the German-speaking population as its target population. The survey instrument for the study was developed by the Berlin Institute for Empirical Integration and Migration Research (BIM).
The practical implementation of the study was carried out by the Center for Empirical Social Research (ZeS) at the Institute of Social Sciences at Humboldt University in Berlin. ZeS was responsible for the technical realization of the research project, which included sample design, questionnaire implementation in CATI format, interviewer training, fieldwork execution, as well as aspects of data editing and weighting. Due to the large sample size and time constraints, some of the fieldwork was conducted in collaboration with the university-affiliated Social Science Survey Center Duisburg (SUZ). The sample was based on a Dual-Frame approach following the Gabler-Hader method and was provided by the Leibniz Institute for the Social Sciences (GESIS).


